



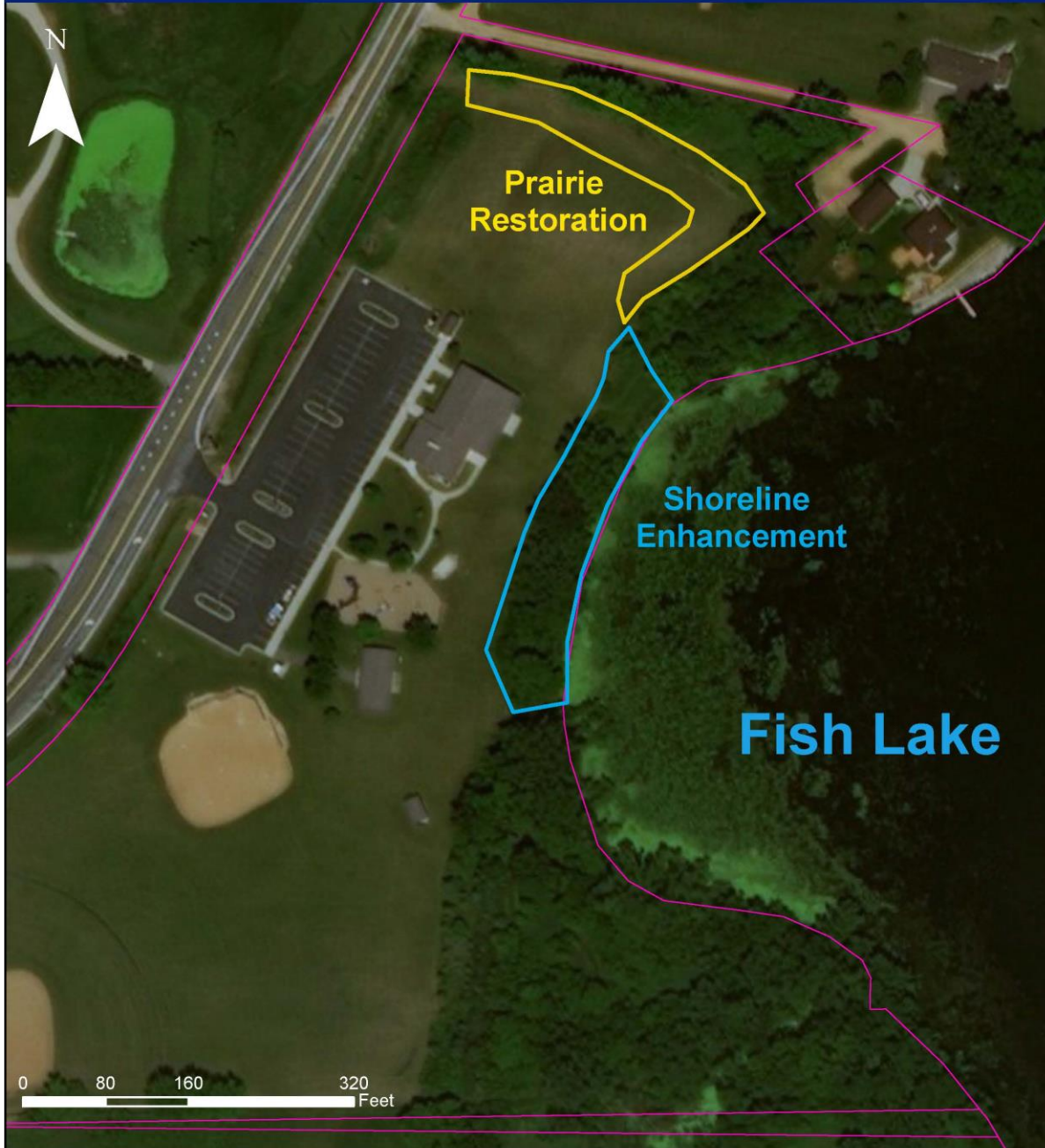
Fish Lake Shoreline Enhancement & Prairie Restoration

This project is a partnership between Spring Lake Township and the Prior Lake-Spring Lake Watershed District. The project will restore a section of shoreline along Fish Lake behind Spring Lake Town Hall and create a prairie restoration on the north side of the town hall. The project will improve habitat for wildlife and pollinators and provide landowners interested in completing restorations on their own properties an opportunity to view an example of a rain garden (existing project), prairie or shoreline restoration.

The project is partially funded by the Prior Lake-Spring Lake Watershed District and by a Conservation Partners Legacy Grant from Legacy Amendment funding through the Lessard-Sams Outdoor Heritage Council (L-SOHC).

Project Timeline: Work on the project began Spring 2019 with site prep. Native plant seeding on the prairie area and shoreline will occur in fall 2019. The turf grass was sprayed in the prairie area and invasive species will be removed from the shoreline before seeding occurs. Maintenance will occur to help the native plant species become established and keep invasive species out of the restoration area.
